2018 was another exciting year at AOTV and WVAO-LP. As we celebrate our Annual Meeting theme *Your Voice Matters* we look to make sure we create a welcoming environment to allow your Freedom of Speech to be heard.

Starting the year, Shane Brown won the Mass Creator Awards Best Drama for *War of the Worlds*. Not stopping there, he submitted our other radio drama to the National Hometown Video Awards and won First Place for Audio Programming for *A Christmas Carol*. It's the first national award that AOTV has received. I was honored to be at the Alliance for Community Media Conference and accept it on Shane's behalf.



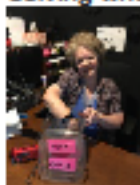
In technology, there is always something new. It was time to complete the last of the upgrades needed to have all the equipment be High Definition. In the winter, there were new remote systems installed in the Athol and Orange town halls. In the spring, just in time for River Rat Race, a new TriCaster switcher was installed in the Production Truck. Late in the year, a Comrex system was purchased to send a video signal from remote locations, via cell service technology, back to the studio. The first beta test was to stream the Thanksgiving Day game live from Athol HS.

Fun times happened in the area, including the Premiere of *Castle Rock* at Monty Tech. Location Scouts looked at many TV studios in Central Mass before choosing the AOTV studio for Episode 3 *Local Color*. Shane was an extra, and we were "hired" as camera operators to shoot the show inside the show.

New volunteers are always welcomed to AOTV and WVAO, but sometimes we need to say goodbye to others. Due to time commitments and new opportunities there are two fantastic people, and former Board Members, who needed to volunteer at AOTV less often. Wayne "Lumpy" Richardson had been known for silly pranks but also a voice of reason and problem solving when he was the AOTV President.



Diana "De" Towle has stepped back from the radio station Chief Operator position but was still available to help at Auction time and other large productions. De was instrumental in getting WVAO off the ground when we first went on air. A big shout-out is well-deserved to these two selfless individuals.



Message from Carol



Channel-slamming is a term used by the access world when Charter Communications moved all the access channels across their territory to Channels 1301 and 1302, better known as Siberia. Our channels were moved in October 2018. The Development Committee worked hard getting the word out, so that viewers can still find us. Spectrum will not cablecast the PEG channels in HD, even though AOTV can provide an HD signal. Many viewers will not surf channels other than the HD tier, so we lose potential audience. To help viewers find the channels easier, an instructional video was posted on the AOTV website which shows viewers how to store channel 1301 as a favorite channel.



Along with channel changes there are a lot of other challenges for PEG Access now and in the future. All PEG Access Centers are faced with revenue issues. The first reason is cord-cutting. Many cable subscribers have disconnected and are getting their entertainment from other sources. Most of AOTV funds come from the subscribers of cable TV, so it will hurt the bottom line.

The next issue is the FCC declaring a ruling that may allow the cable companies to deduct "in-kind" services from the franchise payment. Therefore, AOTV may receive substantially less money in the future. The Board wrote a letter to the FCC along with thousands of others to oppose the ruling. It is still being fought because it hasn't passed the final phase for implementation.

Another significant change comes from the state of Massachusetts. To track all funds, the Department of Revenue is requiring that all towns in Massachusetts set up a special revenue account for access fees. To receive the money from towns of Athol and Orange it will now require a vote at Town Meeting. There will be an article on the warrant in both towns to create the fund.

As we celebrate Freedom of Speech tonight it's interesting to see that the Supreme Court will be reviewing a case to decide if Access Centers are state actors for the purpose of the First Amendment.

AOTV will be celebrating 25 years next year and I ask for your help to continue the mission.

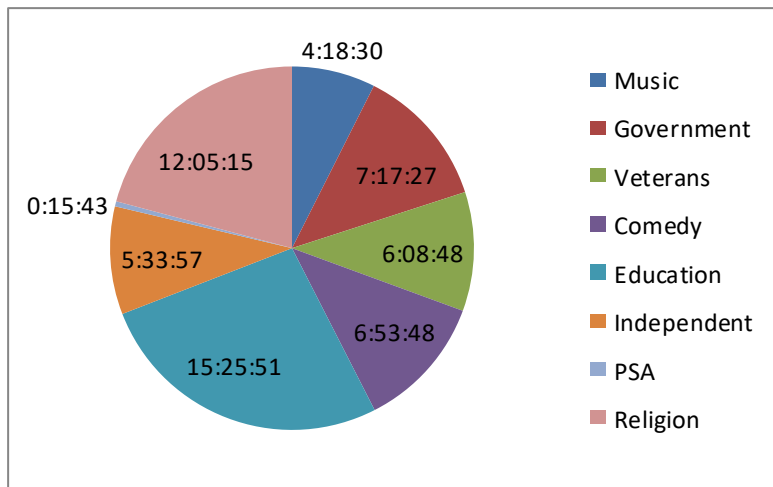
First Runs In House Programs 2018

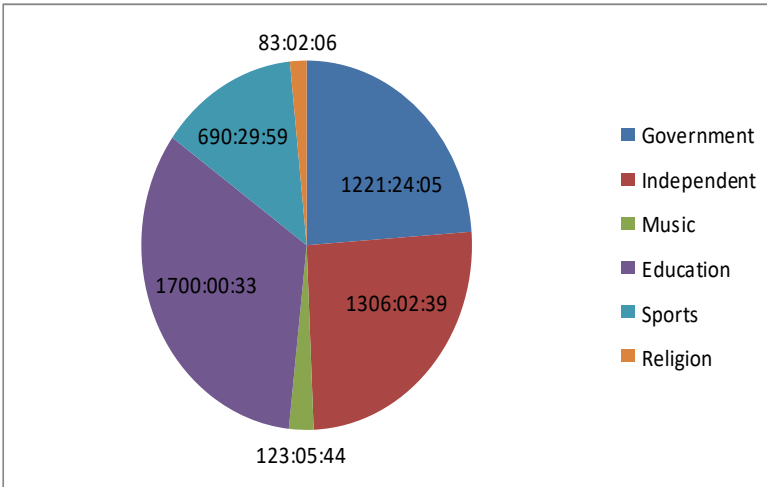
First Runs Outside Programs 2018

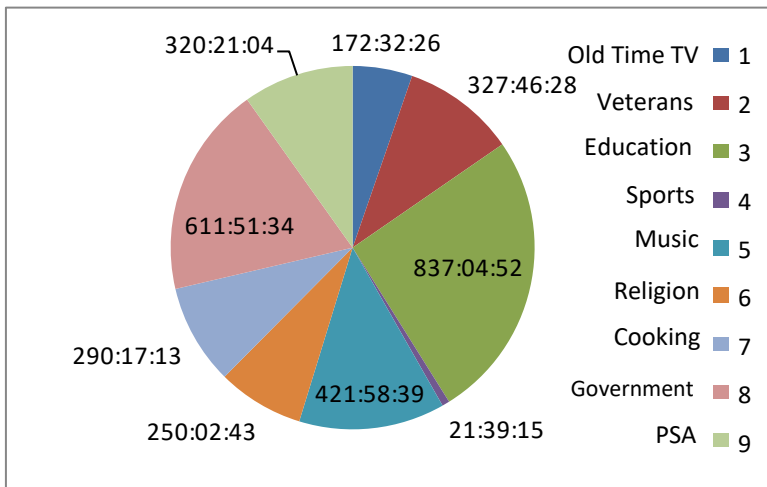
In House Programming 2018

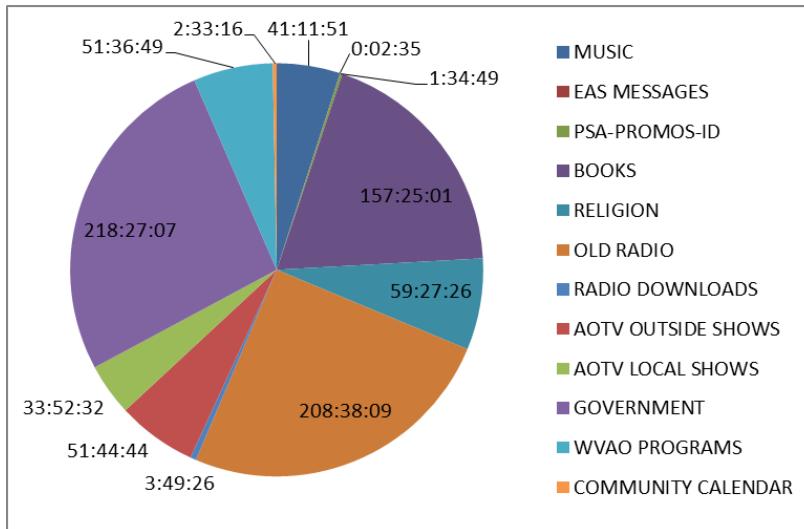

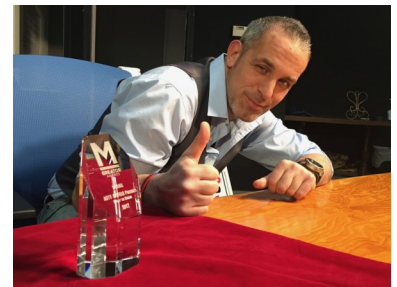
