VOLUNTEERS WORKING For a Better Community Dear Friends,

2019 seems very typical for AOTV. There were many very successful TV productions throughout the year. However, each of these productions is anything but typical. The 56th River Rat Race utilized 12 cameras, 3Go Pros, a Drone and 45 volunteers to pull off this massive production. It is important to remember that other access centers our size or larger would never even attempt this size and quality of a production.

Food-a-thon raised over \$28,000 and eight tons of food in 12 hours. Volunteers from AOTV and the community came together for the 16th time to help their fellow neighbor. Volunteers arrive at 4:30 in the morning, or rush from work to help for the late shift. It always amazed me what we accomplish together.

With the help of the new Tricaster in the Production Truck and the Comrex system, the football season was "live" on TV and radio. We were able to get over \$3,000 in sponsorships to alleviate the costs of the productions. Again, thanks to all the volunteers who were at the football fields late on Friday nights so we were able to produce a quality multi-camera shoot to the community.

The 24th Annual AOTV Auction was able to gross almost \$30,000 with all the help and support of all the incredible volunteers that come back year after year.

To top off the year, Shane produced a live production of "A Christmas Carol" with all the foley sound effects and a live band. Boy, that was fun!

With all the TV productions happening, we also reworked the scheduling of WVAO 105.9FM. Instead of using Audio Journal for many hours per day, we started scheduling all the hours 24/7, so there was much more local programming and many hours of enjoyable music to listen to.

We trained 25 new TV producers and 21 new radio programmers this year. It's still excites me to see new volunteers learn and create their own shows. Message From Carol



Unfortunately, 2019 was a year of uncertainty. The Federal Communications Commission pass a ruling that would allow cable companies to deduct in-kind donations from the franchise fees that make up the bulk of AOTV's revenue. The Board and I decided to be frugal. We did not expand staff or have any large capital purchases in 2019.

I will say that we are very good at being frugal. Looking at Profit and Loss Statement in this report indicates that we were in the black by almost \$59,000 this year. With the uncertainty of the ruling and cable cord cutting hurting many communities, the Alliance for Community Media recommended to have a year's worth of revenue set aside in a rainy day fund. They were suggesting that we may see a 30-50% reduction in revenues. For years, AOTV's policy was to have three months We went from \$65,000 set aside, to almost saved. \$125,000 by December 31. If capital funds are included, we have close to \$200,000. I have a sense of gratitude to the cable subscribers in the area for continuing to subscribe to cable television. In Massachusetts, many towns revenues went down by 10-15%, however the Spectrum customers in Athol and Orange only dropped by 1.5%.

As I write this report, the celebration for AOTV's 25th Anniversary is bittersweet. Instead of having a huge party as I present this report, we will be practicing social distancing. The Coronavirus (COVID-19) is just starting to ramp up in the United States so we needed to postpone the party.

Having spent the last few months going through pictures and video from 1995 to 2020, my thoughts and reflections are mostly of friendships. I want to thank all the people who have come through AOTV in the past 25 years. Each and every one has made my daily work more fulfilling. One intriguing aspect of the last 25 years is that there are many volunteers who moved away only to be welcomed back many years later. I treasure all the friendships and I look forward to many more.
